

# Psycho-Educational Assessment - Summary Sheet

All applicants with a Specific Learning Difficulty must submit a full psycho-educational assessment completed by an appropriately qualified psychologist. This report must be less than 3 years old i.e. must be dated after 1st February 2007.

The Summary Sheet should only be completed where relevant information has been omitted from the original psycho-educational assessment and is not available from the completed report. The original assessment report must also be submitted.

The Summary Sheet must be completed by an appropriately qualified psychologist. The Summary Sheet must be less than 3 years old i.e. must be dated after 1st February 2007.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all sections of the Summary Sheet are completed. Remember to keep a photocopy for your personal records.
